Technology/Classroom Supplies Reimbursement List

Your AEA bargaining team is proud to negotiate a one-time \$600 technology stipend, inclusive of any items for which you were previously reimbursed. It is important to know that this is a **ONE-TIME** reimbursement, and it comes out of your \$500 tuition reimbursement (plus \$100 when you move into hybrid)

- *If you have already received a reimbursement from the distance learning MOU up to \$250, you may submit receipts for the remaining amount of money from \$600.*
- *Please note, that you may still set aside some money for tuition reimbursement, but it comes out of this money (up to \$500 for tuition reimbursement).*
 - *If you are planning on taking PD in the summer and want to be reimbursed, be sure to save that amount from your \$500 tuition reimbursement.*
- *The additional money for technology or supplies that was bargained is under the **PK-5 HYBRID MOU and Secondary MOU**. You may submit your receipts and the form once your grade level has moved to hybrid.*

The items that are approved:

- *Apple MacBooks (sorry no iPads or air buds accepted)*
- *headsets*
- *microphone*
- *docking station*
- *webcam*
- *document camera*
- *laptop/desktop computers*
- *monitor stand*
- *halo light*
- *hotspot*
- *Wi-Fi booster*
- *internet upgrade*
 - *You will be expected to submit a bill with one level of internet and then another bill clearly showing that you increased speed.*
- *Some digital subscriptions*
- *Other classroom supplies needed for hybrid instruction.*

Items NOT approved:

- *Ink*
- *Printers*
- *Paper*
- *furniture*
